With that being said, when you get back to hitting balls you should be most concerned with your quality of strike. One of the easiest ways to practice this is to place an alignment stick or towel a couple of inches behind the golf ball. Begin with chip/pitch shots and make sure you elude the towel/stick and you'll be guaranteed a quality strike and forward shaft lean.



We made it through all winter long without much snow and then winter storm "Stella" hit. I measured 22 inches of snow, which is way more than what we got all winter. With that being said, I am very optimistic when the snow melts we will have a great spring and summer. Going into the snow, I was very pleased with the health of the entire golf course.
