## Wes's Words of Wisdom

Having trouble hitting your fairways woods thin or heavy off a tight lie in the fairway? If this sounds like you, your swing is bottoming out too early. Many golfers believe you should sweep the ball off the ground. However, if you look at the best players in the world, they hit the ball with a descending blow and take a small divot. Think of a fairway wood as an iron and don't try to help the ball get into the air. This will improve your fairway wood play.
