## Wes's Words of Wisdom

I'd like to welcome everyone back for another golf season. Hopefully spring weather arrives soon so everyone can get out and work on their golf game. Fortunately, if the weather doesn't cooperate we have a new addition to SCC, the Foresight GC Quad. This golf simulator and launch monitor is now available to use indoors. The Foresight GC Quad is the #1 launch monitor in the world and we're fortunate to have it at SCC. The Quad delivers ball data and more importantly, clubhead data to backup why your ball does what it does. The Quad will be very useful for lessons and for club fittings because it delivers concrete numbers to help improve your golf swing and get you the right fit for your clubs. While very useful, the Quad gives golfers lots of information which can be overwhelming and confusing to those that aren't familiar with it. However, if you have any questions regarding operation of the Quad or your numbers, please reach out to me and I'll help explain the information that is being relayed. In future newsletters, I will be going over some of the numbers and what golfers should look for when using the Quad. Lastly, I'd like to thank everyone who contributed to allow us to get this top of the line launch monitor, as it will certainly make SCC all that more appealing.



April is here and hopefully with that comes nice warm weather. As many of you have noticed while playing your round, my crew and I cut many trees down this winter. It was necessary for the fact that they were all dying. Pictured below you will see the tree we cut on number 11. This tree was infected by the emerald ash borer. Females lay eggs in bark crevices on ash trees, and larvae feed underneath the bark of ash trees to emerge as adults in one to two years. Within that time it kills the tree and there is no coming back. As time goes by we will be taking down the other ash trees on the course that are infected. You will also see a few pine trees that were taken because they are past their prime and also dying.
