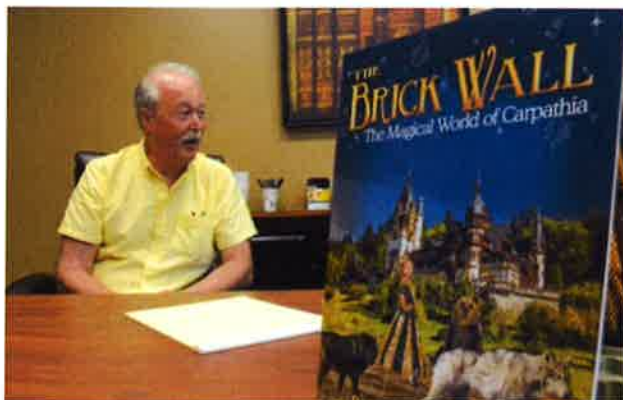

Wes's Words of Wisdom



Every day I look up on the range, see golfers with a similar back swing motion. Golfers take the club too far to the inside which causes them to lift the club to the top and then throw the club and right shoulder out towards the ball. This causes the club to come from outside the target line and across the ball, causing a pull or slice. To correct this common error, keep your club head outside your hands on the takeaway. Then, on the downswing, feel like you're a boxer throwing an uppercut instead of a right hook. This will drop the club to the inside and have you hitting that much desired draw every amateur golfer desires.

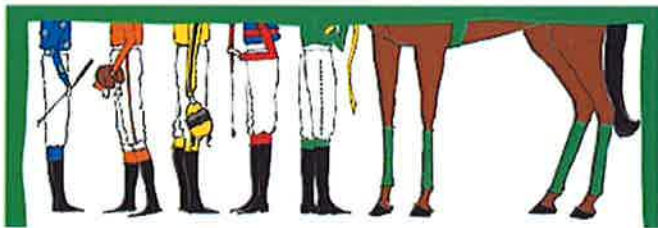
