## “Steep on the Forward Swing”

Ask yourself this, do I tend to hit pulls, slices or hit shots off the toe of the club? If so, you can guarantee you are probably too steep on the forward swing. What can you do to fix it? Besides coming for a lesson, I'd recommend trying a couple of these drills.

- Try hitting balls on a sidehill lie with the ball above your feet. Get the feeling of a more rounded swing into the ball.
- Learn to make some baseball swings; feel like you are playing tee ball and you will develop a lower arm swing into impact.
- High Tee Drill
  - To do this drill, use a fairway wood and tee the ball an inch or two off the ground.
  - Make  $\frac{1}{2}$  swings to a full finish only trying to hit the ball 100-150 yards.
  - If you struggle with this drill and continuously sky the ball (leaving marks on the top of your club) or hit the tee and break it with the ball going nowhere you can guarantee you are still too steep. It will frustrate you at first but if you stick with it and start hitting a draw you are on your way to flattening the shaft and hitting the center of the clubface.
