Luke's Words of Wisdom

I'm filling in for Wes this month because he is on vacation. I can't possibly talk about the golf swing like he does so I'm going to take a different route and discuss course management. I was young and dumb on the golf course for a long time and I'm now starting to grow older and wiser. I'm far from an expert on this topic, but I've recently come to appreciate and understand golf course architecture. We are lucky enough to have one of the greatest architects of all time, Donald Ross, design half of our course. He's well known for his phenomenal green complexes and one of my favorites is the 3rd green. The 3rd's turtleback green is very similar to greens at the world-renowned Pinehurst #2. At Schuylkill's 3rd, any approach that is left or long will be thrown off the green into a closely mowed area and any that is short right will end up in the greenside bunker. The green can be very difficult to hit when your approach is too close (inside 50) and too far away (over 150). My words of wisdom are next time you play number three, try leaving yourself with around a 75-125 approach shot. You'll notice that this is the best distance to come into the this beautifully designed turtleback green. If you do happen to miss left or long, take a second to think about how you want to play your next shot. Donald Ross's closely mown areas around the greens presents you with a variety of options such as putting, bump and runs, and even flop shots. I hope you join me in learning to appreciate the tremendous course architecture we have at SCC, and I guarantee that if you do you'll have a lot more putts for birdies and pars! Thanks for reading, Luke.

Normally we are watering and trying to keep everything green in the summer months, but with all the extra moisture we are cutting more than ever. I have my fingers crossed that the rain holds off and we can dry out for the upcoming months.

On a side note, I would like to take this time to inform everyone that throughout the golf course we have very many ash trees. In the last few years in Pennsylvania, the Emerald ash borer has become a problem. The larvae feed on the vascular tissues between the bark and sapwood, a habit that interrupts the flow of nutrients and water required by the tree, thus usually killing the tree within a few years. We will be taking the trees down that have been affected within the upcoming months.
