SCC In The News...

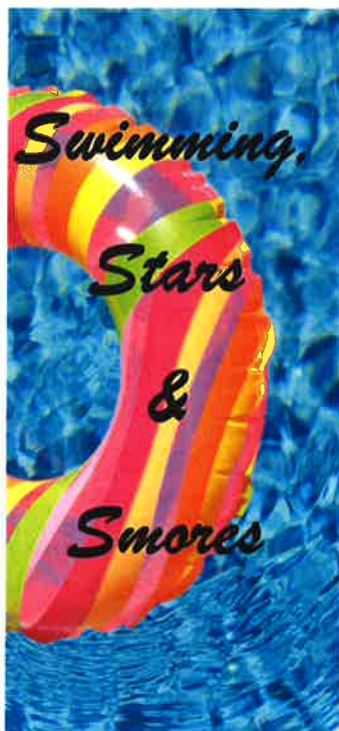

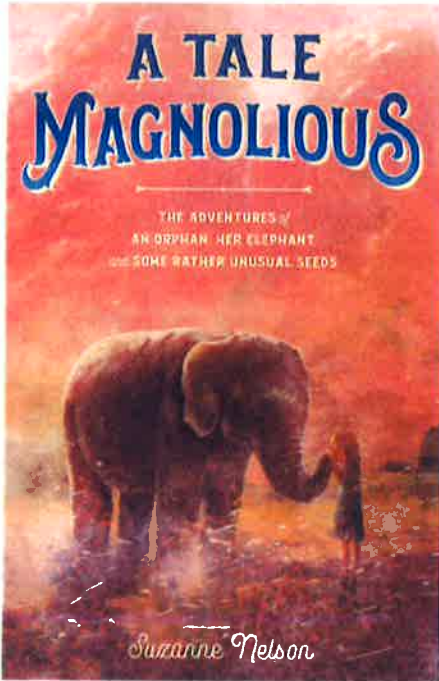
