Wes's Words of Wisdom



One of the things I frequently hear on the lesson tee is that the person wants more distance. Sound like you? Many times, people are looking for a quick fix or automatically think something is wrong with their swing. I often ask if they are hitting the ball in the middle of the club face. Quick solution, go get some Dr. Scholl's Foot Spray and spray it on your driver/woods and you will quickly see where you are contacting it on the club face. For irons, get a dry erase marker and mark the back of the ball. Remember, hitting the ball off the toe or heel will not only lose you distance but also influences the way the golf ball curves in the air.



I hope everyone has enjoyed the year of golf that the course has provided. As the New Year rings in, we will be working hard to get all the equipment maintained and ready for the 2017 season. We will also be cutting some dead trees down around the course that need to be taken down for safety concerns.
