Wes's Words of Wisdom

In this month's newsletter we will be diving into the swing of member Jim Amato. Jim came for a lesson without any previous instruction and struggled with a ball that curved to the right. Here is what we worked on during the lesson. (Before on the left, after on the right)

During the takeaway, Jim had a tendency to roll his forearms which opened the face and got his trail hand under the club. Club was much more in line on the right.

As you can see, a club that gets inside your hands during the takeaway produces a shaft that gets flat and makes you lift the club to the top. On the right, Jim's club shaft is much more vertical and the clubface is in a much better position.



Night and Day after an hour or so, because of an open clubface during the backswing, Jim must make compensations on the downswing to get his clubface square at impact. He did this by throwing the clubface outside his hands during the downswing which produced a pull or pull fade. On the right, we got Jim's clubface in a better position in the backswing which in turn helped him deliver the club from the inside on the downswing. If you get the clubface into the position on the right you will be in a great position to strike the ball. Remember if you struggle with a pull or slice, chances are your clubface gets open at sometime in the backswing. Fixing the face FIRST should be your #1 priority. If you struggle with a hook, fix the path first, chances are your face is ok you just swing to far to the right for a right handed golfer.

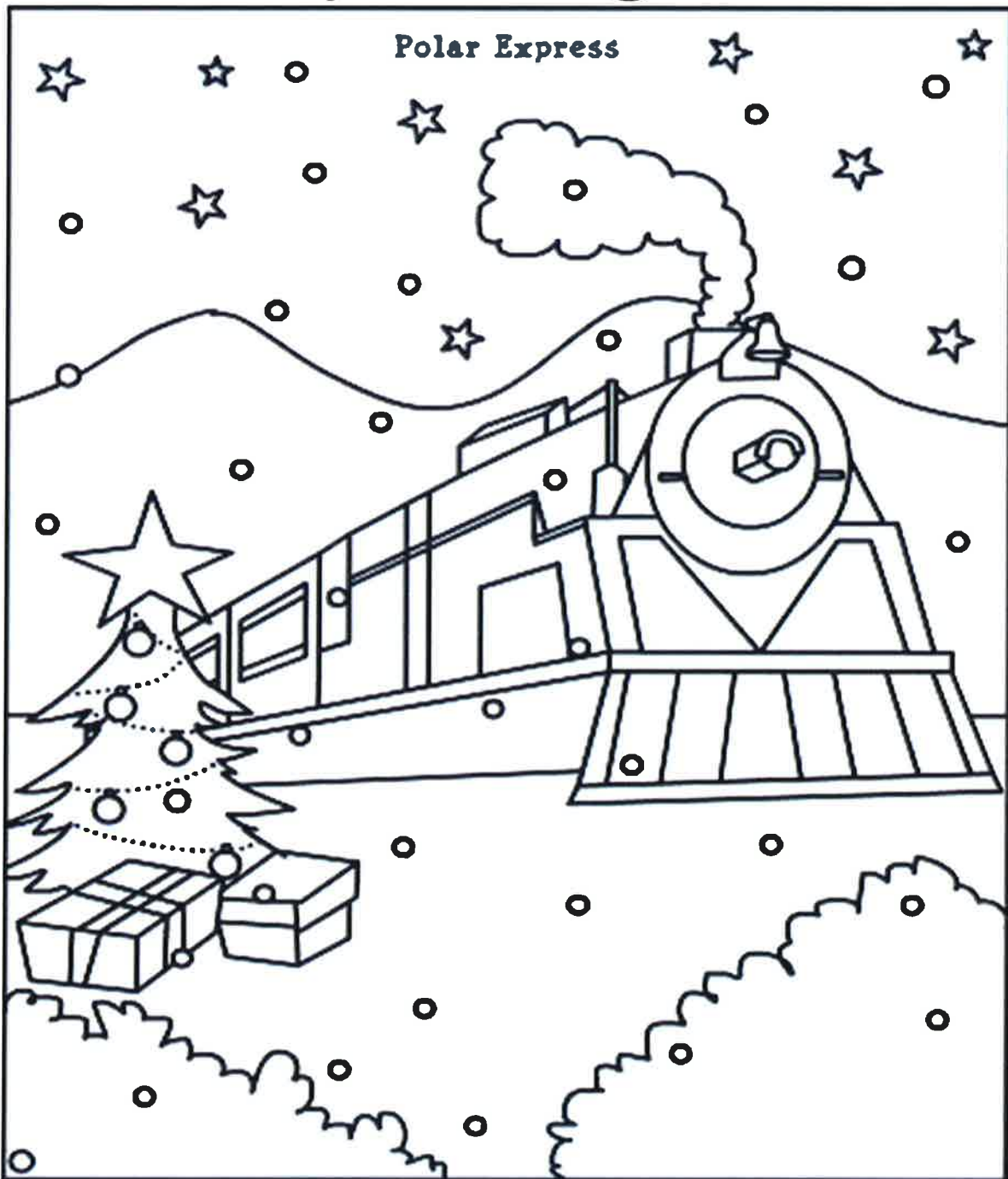
