



Wes's Words of Wisdom

With Brooks Koepka recently winning the USOpen, I thought it would be beneficial to take a piece out of his swing that could help you. If you look at the picture to the right, look how Brooks' clubface is in a extremely strong position with the face looking at the golf ball. Many of you roll the clubface open in the early stages of the backswing which immediately gets your swing off track. Copy Brooks' position early in the backswing and you will be in a much better position to strike the golf ball.





You will see some recent improvements on the golf course.

- •Left of 16-removed the dead pine trees and exposed the beautiful oak tree. We are in the process of growing some grass in that area.
- •Built a new ladies' tee on hole 15. For both spots we ask that everyone be mindful of the roped off areas. Thank you for your cooperation.
- •Bathrooms on the right of 5 are open. We have some last minute details to address before it is completely finished.
