Wes's Words of Wisdom

More frequent than not the first thing to go wrong in a golfer's swing is the initial move away from the ball. The golfer tends to move the club head first which causes the takeaway to be low and to the inside. Try making a small move; weight shift into your right foot and have the grip and shaft move before the club head does. This will get you into a better spot in the backswing and set you up for a much better sequence coming down to hit the ball.
