Wes's Words of Wisdom

Bunker Shots

How many of you instantly panic when your approach shot finds a greenside bunker? I'm here to tell you shouldn't, greenside bunker shots should be the easiest shot in golf. I say that because you can hit anywhere from a half an inch to 2 inches behind the ball and still end up alright. Based on the condition of the sand in the bunker, here's how you should play each shot:

Fluffy Sand:

- > Pick a wedge with more bounce (10 or more)
- > Address the ball with a SLIGHTLY open stance
- > Play the ball forward of center and position your hands so that the shaft doesn't lean toward the target
- > Weight on your lead side
- > Open the clubface so it looks at the sky thus utilizing the bounce
- > Take your swing and hit THROUGH the shot hitting slightly behind the ball, acceleration is KEY

Firm Wet Sand:

- > Pick a wedge with less bounce (8 or less)
- > Play the ball just ahead of center
- > Weight forward
- > Square the clubface so that the leading edge is more exposed
- > Because the sand is hard, make a more aggressive swing to pop the ball out and onto the green
