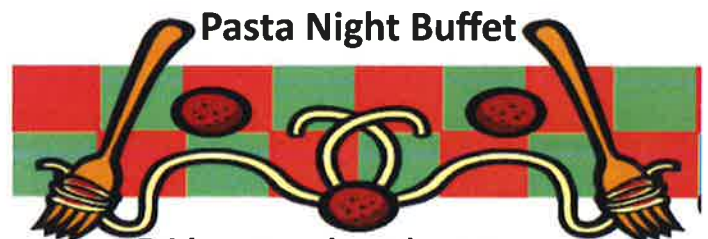

## *Wes's* Words of Wisdom

In a month or so, the new golf season will be in full swing. In preparation for the new season, everyone would be wise to get in the simulator and get their golf muscles a head start on the upcoming year. While in the simulator, take advantage of the great GC Quad device. While playing different courses is fun, do not forget that the device can help you determine your distance gapping for your clubs. Ideally, you should have a 10-15 yard gap between clubs, if your swing speed is on the lower side, your gapping might be 7-10 yards. The important thing is to make sure your clubs are not going the same distances and you are getting the most out of your set. If you need help figuring out your yardages or just have a question about certain numbers you are getting, don't hesitate to reach out to me to discuss. Once again, the GC Quad is a fantastic device that we are fortunate to have. Get on the simulator before the season starts to have your best season yet!

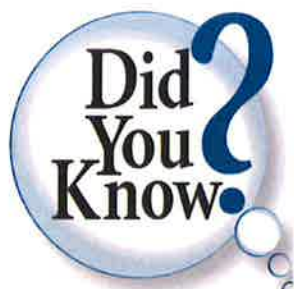
