# Wes's Words of Wisdom



How many of you reading this would like more distance with their driver? I am here to tell you that with a few simple adjustments at setup you'll be hitting your driver higher, longer, and better than ever before.

Here's a checklist of things you should be doing:

- \* Tee the ball high so that half the ball is above the top of the club head.
- \* Position the golf ball off your front instep and feel as if your front shoulder is behind the golf ball.
- \* Tilt your spine away from the target so your head is more behind the golf ball.
- \* You should feel that your front shoulder is much higher than your back shoulder for a right handed golfer.
- \* At setup, look more at the underside of the ball.
- \* When hitting the ball feel as if you catching it on the upswing, this will launch the ball higher with less spin and maximize distance.

## Drill

Tee the ball up and take your driver and position it in front of the tee. Then, get an EMPTY sleeve of balls and position it a club heads' width in front of the golf ball. If you make your swing and hit the sleeve, you know you are hitting down on the ball and robbing yourself of distance. If you miss the sleeve, you are hitting up on the ball and maximizing distance.



After what turned out to be a pretty nice April, the Schuylkill Country Club rolls into May in excellent condition. A little bit of hard work combined with favorable weather conditions has our golf course in great shape for this time of year. We are happy to say that both XGD drainage projects on #5 and #7 were a success. Between rolling both greens everyday and keeping the moisture level sufficient, both greens have come back nicely. Our spring aerification will take place on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Improved drainage and an increase in oxygen levels are just two major benefits of why we aerify our greens twice a year. As we strive to have the course in the best condition possible, we wish the best of luck to all our members on a successful May.
