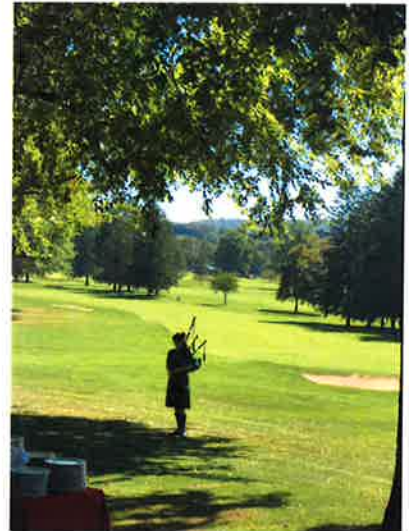

Wedge Bounce Rules

- If the sand is Firm, Use Less Bounce
- If the sand is Fluffy, Use More Bounce
- Tight Lies, Use Less Bounce
- Heavier Lies, Use More Bounce
- If your angle of attack is Steep, You Need More Bounce
- If your angle of attack is Shallow, You Need Less Bounce



You may notice we have piles of dirt around a few spots in the rough. We will be spreading it out in bare spots that need a little help. You will also see some trees coming down as there are very many pine trees on our golf course that are way past their prime.
