Wes's Words of Wisdom



Having trouble with distance control on your long putts? Are you also having trouble hitting the center of the putter clubface? If so, practice the "Gate Drill" with the putter. Go to the putting green and push two tees in the ground outside the heel and toe, forming a gate for the putter head to swing through. Now practice swinging your putter head through without hitting the tees which will guarantee a centered strike and true roll. Tiger Woods does this drill before every one of his rounds! If it's good enough for Tiger, I'm sure it will help you out during your next round.



Fall is upon us as the leaves are changing and dropping fast. I am hoping that this fall/winter is similar to last year, so everyone can enjoy a few more rounds of golf.
