Wes's Words of Wisdom



A common question I get on the lesson tee is, "when should I start my downswing"? The answer to this question shouldn't be thinking of the backswing and downswing as 2 separate movements. Golfers should think of the backswing and downswing as a joint movement. Think of a quarterback throwing a football or baseball player throwing a baseball, they both step forward with their lead foot as their arm is going back. It is the same principal in golf, as the clubhead works back and gets just past hip height, the golfer should already be creating pressure into their lead foot to initiate the downswing. To get a feeling for this move, the step drill is a simple yet highly effective drill to try to incorporate into your swing. First, put both feet together, and as you initially take the club back, you will simultaneously step toward the target with your front foot and swing. This will force you to start the downswing with your lower body, not your arms, and help create a more powerful swing.

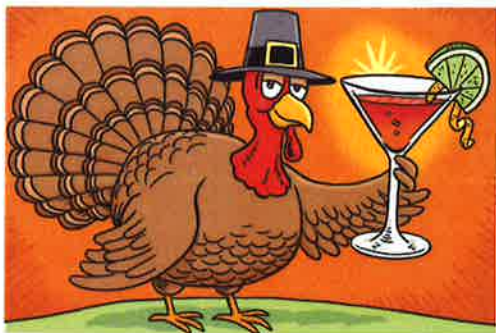
