## Wes's Words of Wisdom

As a guy who loves looking at golf swings, I'm always watching others and asking myself why certain players do what they do and the resulting shot pattern. Certain positions and matchups in the golf swing often tell you all you need to know when it comes to ball flight. In this month's article, I'll dig into Ryan Laudeman's golf swing and point out certain aspects of his swing that I like and that I believe can help you.



At position 3 or left arm parallel to the ground, Ryan gets the club shaft pointing inside the ball. Having the club shaft vertical at this point sets it up to shallow out or lay down later in the swing. His "clubface" is in a strong position, looking at the golf ball. For many of you who struggle with a pull or slice, your shaft would be very flat and pointing outside the golf ball.



Approaching position 6 or club shaft parallel to the ground, you can see Ryan has dropped his club shaft onto a flatter plane that points outside the golf ball. Getting into this position with a clubface that is angled towards the ball sets him up to attack the ball from the inside and hit a ball that draws. For those of you who hit pulls or slices, the club shaft would point inside the ball on a very steep angle and the clubface would be out in front of you instead of behind you like Ryan's. When working on your golf swing, it's important to get the backswing right first as it will setup the rest of your swing. Do this and I know you'll be on the right track to straighter, more solid golf shots.



# Tee to Green

We are down to our last two months of 2019 here at the Schuylkill Country Club. It is just a matter of time before the entire course is coated in a layer of white and the only green in sight will be clubhouse Christmas Trees. The grounds crew will continue wrapping up the 2019 season all November long. Soon you will be seeing the removal of benches, ball washers, and bird houses.

We will continue battling the leaves even into November and finish up aerifying fairways so they're ready to go for 2020. Greens aerification was a success this fall and as they continue to heal we are hoping for much more ideal putting conditions all November long.
