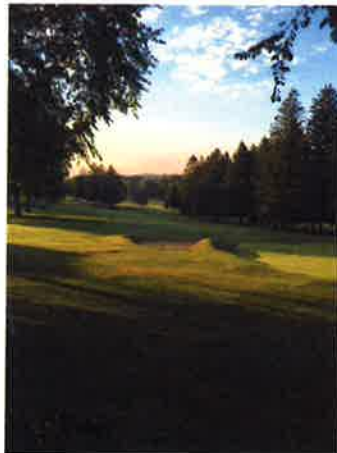

Wes's Words of Wisdom



Ball Position

One of the most underrated parts of setting up to hit a golf ball is ball position. Often when giving a lesson I can usually tell the golfer's ball flight just by looking at his/her ball position. Golfers who swing in-to-out generally have rearward ball positions, and they are golfers who hit a draw/hook. Those who swing out-to-in often have more forward ball positions, and they're usually players who fade/slice the ball. How can this benefit you? If you are hooking the ball, move the ball forward. Slicing the ball? Move it back.
