## Wes's Words of Wisdom

With the ridiculous amount of rain we have gotten this summer, I have recently been asked questions regarding how to play from the bunkers when the sand is firm and wet. First and foremost, you want to play a wedge with a low bounce (4-8 degrees). After selecting the right bounce, put more on your front foot and don't open the clubface as you normally would. Now, just make your normal bunker shot swing and you will have no problem getting out of the sand.

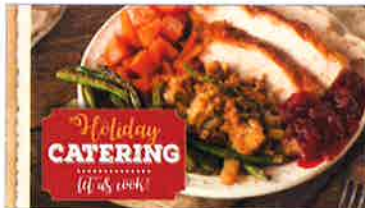
