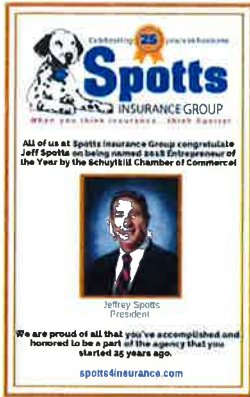

Wes's Words of Wisdom

One of the biggest flaws I see on the lesson tee is golfers preoccupied on moving the clubhead down to the ball at the top of the swing. The upper body is over rotating which moves the clubhead away from the body in an over the top, steepening action. Look at accomplished players and you'll see them instinctively allow the clubhead to drop behind them as they initiate the downswing. Next time you are hitting balls on the range, work on letting the clubhead get behind you at the start of the downswing and you will start attacking the ball more from the inside and start hitting powerful golf shots.



This month's featured piece of equipment is our sprayer, pictured to the left. Applying chemicals to the greens on the golf course is essential to success. Fertilizer, fungicides, insecticides, plant growth regulators and other chemicals all play an important role in producing tournament quality putting surfaces. This is a vital part of our fleet and helps to keep diseases away and fertilizes our entire property.

While driving on the course with a cart, we ask everyone to keep their carts a safe distance from the greens. Please keep your distance so the area around the green does not get flattened down. Also, after hitting a great shot onto the green please make sure to look for your ball mark. A good rule of thumb is if you fix yours and one other the greens will stay in great shape for the next player.
